

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING SUPPLIES ON VISITING DAY OR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- Change of clothes (including underwear, socks, etc.) in large zip-lock bag; clothes & bag **LABELED** with child's name
(This is for paint spills and other accidents!)
- Student lunch box – **labeled***
- Student reusable water bottle – **labeled***
- One 24-count box crayons (Crayola brand preferred) – **labeled***
- 6 small glue sticks
- 1 dozen **sharpened** pencils
- 1 family photograph (4" x 6" preferred)

We have containers to hold items, so no supply box is needed.

Please: NO backpacks.

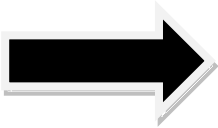

GRADE 1 SUPPLY LIST

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING SUPPLIES TO VISITING DAY OR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- 1 24-count box of crayons
- 1 dozen pencils - sharpened
- 1 set of 12 colored pencils - sharpened
- 1 package “pink pearl” erasers (not “pencil toppers”)
- 1 10-count box Crayola broad line markers
- 4 sturdy “pocket folders”

Note: Because storage space is limited, we encourage our First Graders to “travel light.” Their daily “load” should be a lunchbox for snack/lunch and their folder. Thank you for your support!

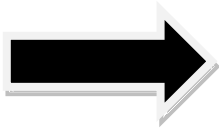

GRADE 2 SUPPLY LIST

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING SUPPLIES TO VISITING DAY OR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- 1 16-count box of crayons
- 1 Pair of Fiskars scissors – not round points
- 1 set colored pencils
- 2 pencil sharpeners
- 1 set colored markers
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 sturdy “pocket folder” for Homework
- Three 2-pocket folders
- 2 highlighters (any color)
- 2 packages large erasers
- Nylon pencil pouch with reinforced holes to fit 3-ring binder
- 1 set Crayola watercolor paints (8 colors)

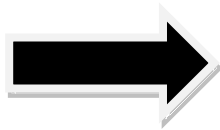

GRADE 3 SUPPLY LIST

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING SUPPLIES TO VISITING DAY OR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- 1 pair headphones for use with Chromebooks
- 1 Pair of Fiskars scissors – not round points
- 3 dozen pencils - sharpened
- 2 manual pencil sharpeners
- 3-4 ball-point pens, assorted colors (not black or blue)
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 set fine line colored markers (Papermate Flair or equivalent; NOT Sharpie)
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 sturdy “pocket folder” for Homework (plastic not preferred)
- 4 2-pocket folders
- 2 highlighters, any color
- 3 packages large erasers
- 1 package 3” x 5” lined index cards
- Nylon pencil pouch with reinforced holes to fit 3-ring binder

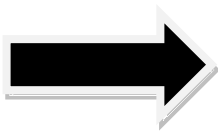

GRADE 4 SUPPLY LIST

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING SUPPLIES ON VISITING DAY OR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- 1 pencil bag or box
- 1 package fine point **Sharpie** pens - black
- 3 packages pencils
- 1 small pencil sharpener (optional)
- 3 glue sticks
- 3 highlighters
- 2 erasers
- 1 bottle white glue
- 4 single-subject spiral notebooks, about 70 sheets, 10½" x 8" for Language Arts, Math, Spanish plus 1 extra
- 2 composition notebooks, lined, 9.75" x 7.5" for Grammar & Picture of the Day
- One 3-ring binders (1½") with clear-view cover for History
- 1 set of binder dividers for 6 History units
- 1 sturdy "pocket folder" for Homework and finished work

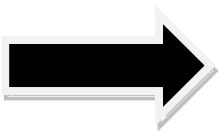

GRADE 5 SUPPLY LIST

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING SUPPLIES TO VISITING DAY OR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- 1 pencil case
- 1 zippered “Trapper Keeper” binder
- 1 package correcting pens – any color except black or blue
- 1 package Fine Point Sharpie pens – Black
- 3 packages pencils
- 5 glue sticks
- 3 highlighters (different colors are great!)
- 2 erasers
- 4 single-subject spiral notebooks, 70 sheets, 10½” x 8” for Language Arts, Math,
Spanish plus 1 extra
- 2 composition notebooks, lined, 9.75” x 7.5” for Grammar and Journal
- One 3-ring binder (1½”) with clear-view cover for History
- 2 sturdy “pocket folders” for Homework and Unfinished Work
- 1 set binder dividers for 6 History units

GRADES 6, 7, & 8 SUPPLY LIST

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING SUPPLIES TO VISITING DAY OR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

Organization is the key! 6th, 7th, & 8th Graders will need to have with them at school every day:

- 1 combination lock for locker
- 1 "Trapper Keeper" type notebook
- Book covers – **non-adhesive**; paper bags preferred
- 1 set of colored pencils
- One zippered pencil bag that fits inside a notebook
- Pencils
- Notebook paper (wide rule)
- Ballpoint pen (blue or black)
- Highlighters (2 or 3 different colors)
- One 3-ring binder (**1"**) with a clear view cover for History
(IMPORTANT: We do not have space for binders that are 2" or 3". Please make sure it is 1")
- One 3-ring binder (**1"**) with clear view cover for Language Arts
(IMPORTANT: We do not have space for binders that are 2" or 3". Please make sure it is 1")
- One 3-ring binder (2") with clear view cover for Science
- One 5-pack tab dividers for Language Arts
- One pack top-loading, 3-hole punched sheet protectors for Language Arts
- 4" x 6" white index cards (200) – loose, **not** perforated, **not** bound sets (**Grade 6 & Grade 7/8 Research students**)
- Spanish/English Dictionary (Grade 7/8 Spanish students)***
- One scientific calculator for Math (Casio fx-300ES Plus or Casio fx-115ES Plus recommended)
- One spiral or composition notebook for Math
- One 6" or 4" clear protractor (no swing arm)
- One 6" or 12" ruler with inch and centimeter markings
- One geometric compass
- Black athletic shorts for PE (Grades 7 & 8) - shorts must be long enough to cover the top half of the thigh

Storage is at a premium. ☺ All student materials (lunches, jackets, etc.) must fit in the lockers. To help with this, each student will be issued a set of Math and History textbooks for home use; TCPS will have second set for classroom use. This will help decrease the daily "load" and be a great support to students.
